THE FOREST ACT

The Forest (Oxford Forest Reserve) Order Resolution, 2016

WHEREAS by virtue of section 5(a) of the Forest Act (hereinafter referred to as the Act) provides that the Minister may by order declare any Crown land as a forest reserve:

AND WHEREAS by virtue of section 10(1)(a) of the Act provides that before an order is made under section 5(a), the Minister shall publish a notice of his intention to make the order and invite in such manner as the Minister thinks fit, comments from the members of the public in relation to such order:

AND WHEREAS by virtue of section 10(1)(b) of the Act, the prescribed ninety days since the publication of the notice has passed:

AND WHEREAS by virtue of section 5 of the Act, an order made under paragraph (a) shall be subject to affirmative resolution:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the Forest (Oxford Forest Reserve)

Order, 2016, be affirmed:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives as follows:-

- 1. This Resolution may be cited as the Forest (Oxford Forest Reserve) Order Resolution, 2016.
- 2. The Forest (Oxford Forest Reserve) Order Resolution, 2016, is hereby affirmed.
