AN ACT to Postpone the holding of a General Election under the Parish Councils Act and for purposes connected therewith.

[*15th July 2010*]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Parish Councils General Election (Postponement) Act, 2010, and shall be read and construed as one with the Parish Councils Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2 [No.] *The Parish Councils General Election
(Postponement) Act, 2010*

Modification of principal Act. 2. During the continuance in force of this Act, the principal Act shall be read and construed as if there were substituted for subsection (1) of section 8, the following subsection—

“ (1) A general election of councillors to serve on each Parish Council shall be held in each parish on such day or days not later than the 31st day of December, 2010, as the Governor-General in Council may by Proclamation appoint.”

Duration of Act. 3. This Act shall continue in force until the 31st day of December, 2010, and shall then expire, unless extended by resolution of each House of Parliament to a date not later than the 31st day of March, 2011, which resolution may amend any other provision of this Act.
