

THE CIVIL SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT ACT

The Civil Service Establishment (General) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2011


In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 3 of the Civil Service Establishment Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:-


1. This Order may be cited as the Civil Service Establishment (General) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2011, and shall be read and construed as one with the Civil Service Establishment (General) Order, 2010 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.
2. Part I of the Schedule to the principal Order is amended by –
 - (a) inserting therein in the appropriate column entries relating to the offices specified in the second column of Part I of the Schedule to this Order and corresponding classifications and grades which offices are hereby established and constituted as offices in the public service, with effect from the respective dates specified in the fifth column of that Part;
 - (b) deleting the entries in relation to the offices abolished pursuant to paragraph 3 of this Order.
3. The offices specified in the second column of Part II of the Schedule to this Order are hereby abolished upon their respectively becoming vacant as specified in the fifth column of that Part.
