THE PARISH COUNCILS GENERAL ELECTION (POSTPONEMENT) ACT

The Parish Councils General Election (Postponement)
Act, 2010 (Extension) Resolution

WHEREAS on the 15th day of July, 2010 the Parish Councils

General Election (Postponement) Act, 2010 (hereinafter referred
to as "the Act"), came into operation:

AND WHEREAS section 2 of the Act provides that a general election of councillors to serve on each Parish Council shall be held in each parish on such day or days not later than the 31st day of December, 2010, as the Governor-General in Council may appoint:

AND WHEREAS by virtue of section 3 of the Act, the Act shall continue in force until the 31st day of December, 2010 and shall then expire, unless extended by resolution of each House of Parliament to a date not later than the 31st day of March 2011:

AND WHEREAS it is considered desirable to extend the duration of the Act until the 31st day of March, 2011, in order to facilitate the further implementation of the Local Government Reform Programme and the establishment of Portmore as the fifteenth parish:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Honourable House as follows:-

- 1. This Resolution may be cited as the Parish Councils General Election (Postponement) Act, 2010 (Extension) Resolution.
- The Parish Councils General Election (Postponement) Act,
 is hereby extended in force until the 31st day of March,
 2011.
