

ANACT to Amend the Tourism Enhancement Act.

[4th day of August 2017

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Tourism Enhancement Short title (Amendment) Act, 2017, and shall be read and construed as one struction. with the Tourism Enhancement Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.

2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by renumbering the Amendment section as section 7(1) and inserting the following as subsection (2)—

" (2) The moneys paid into the Fund under subsection (1) shall be paid over to the Collector of Taxes within seven days after receipt.".

Amendment of section 10 of principal Act.

3. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended in paragraph (e) by inserting next after the word "fee" the words "and paying over the fee in accordance with section 7".

Amendment of section 14 of principal Act. **4.** Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by deleting paragraph (b).

Amendment of section 15 of principal Act. 5. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "resources of the Fund shall" and substituting therefor the words "resources of the Fund, excluding the fees collected under section 10(e), shall".

Amendment of First Schedule of principal Act.

- **6.** The First Schedule of the principal Act is amended in paragraph 4 by—
 - (a) deleting the words "out of the income of the Fund or"; and
 - (b) inserting next after the words "of the Board" the words ", its projects, programmes and other expenses".
