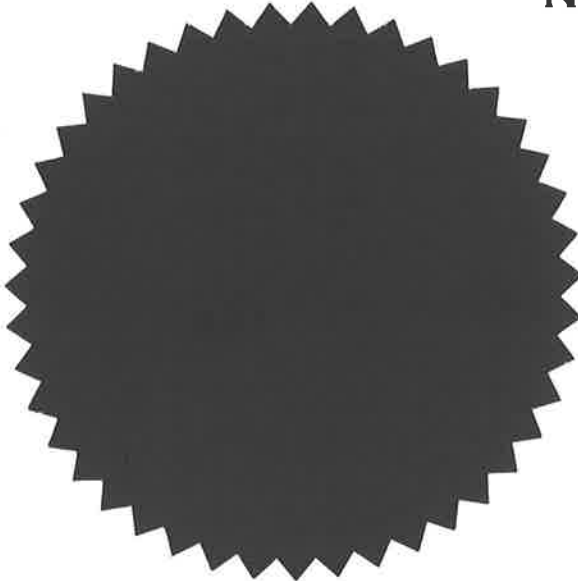

AN ACT to Amend the Income Tax Act.

[*1st day of December 2022*]

BE IT ENACTED by The King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Income Tax (Amendment) Act, 2022, and shall be read and construed as one with the Income Tax Act, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Act”).

2. Section 32A of the principal Act is amended as follows—

- (a) in subsection (4)(a), by inserting next after the word “trade”, the word “business,”;
- (b) in subsection (9), by inserting next after the word “trade”, the word “business,”;

- (c) in subsection (15)(a), by inserting after the word “trade”, the word “business,”;
- (d) by deleting paragraph (c) of subsection (16).

Amendment
of section 38
of principal
Act.

3. Section 38 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1B) as follows—

- (a) in paragraph (a), by inserting after the word “trade,” where it appears, the word “business,”;
- (b) in paragraph (b), by inserting after the word “trade,” where it appears, the word, “business,”.

Amendment
of First
Schedule to
principal Act.

4. The First Schedule to the principal Act is amended in paragraph 5(1)(k) of Part II—

- (a) by deleting the words “Free Zone” where they appear and substituting therefor the words, “Special Economic Zone”; and
- (b) deleting the words “Jamaica Export Free Zones Act” where they appear and substituting therefor the words “Special Economic Zones Act”.
