BE IT ENACTED by The King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Income Tax (Amendment) Short title Act, 2022, and shall be read and construed as one with the Income and commence-Tax Act, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

 - (b) in paragraph (b), by inserting after the word "trade," where it appears, the word, "business,".

Amendment of First Schedule to principal Act.

- **4.** The First Schedule to the principal Act is amended in paragraph 5(1)(k) of Part II—
 - (a) by deleting the words "Free Zone" where they appear and substituting therefor the words, "Special Economic Zone"; and
 - (b) deleting the words "Jamaica Export Free Zones Act" where they appear and substituting therefor the words "Special Economic Zones Act".
