THE FOREST ACT

The Forest (Amity Mountain Forest Reserve) Order, 2016

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 5(a) of the Forest Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as the Forest (Amity Mountain Forest Reserve) Order, 2016.

Schedule.

2. The areas specified in Part I of the Schedule which are delineated on the map set out in Part II thereof, is hereby

declared to be a forest reserve and shall be known as Amity

Mountain Forest Reserve.

SCHEDULE

(Paragraph 2)

Part I. Description of area declared to be Amity Mountain Forest Reserve

The forest reserve to be known as Amity Mountain Forest Reserve, is described as follows:

All that parcel of Crown land situated in the parish of Westmoreland and containing 86 acres (34.82 hectares) and numbered as Lot 25 of Amity Mountain Lands Department Sub-division and butting and bounded as follows –

Northerly

on John Hoggs Patent in the possession of

Theodosia McKenzie of Bath Mountain P.A.;

Easterly

on Lot 24 of said lands and on reserve road;


Southerly

Westerly
