

THE FOREST ACT

**The Forest (Tryall Estate Forest Reserve)
Order Resolution, 2016**

WHEREAS by virtue of section 5(b) of the Forest Act (hereinafter referred to as the Act) provides that the Minister may by order declare any private land, as a forest reserve, if the owner thereof applies in writing for such declaration:

AND WHEREAS section 10(1)(a) of the Act provides that before an order is made under section 5(b), the Minister shall publish a notice of his intention to make the order and invite in such manner as the Minister thinks fit, comments from the members of the public in relation to such order:

AND WHEREAS by virtue of section 10(1) (b) of the Act the prescribed ninety days since the publication of the notice has passed:

AND WHEREAS by virtue of section 5 of the Act, an order made under paragraph (b) shall be subject to affirmative resolution:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the Forest (Tryall Estate Forest Reserve) Order 2016, be affirmed:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives as follows:-

1. This Resolution may be cited as the Forest (Tryall Estate Forest Reserve) Order Resolution, 2016.
2. The Forest (Tryall Estate Forest Reserve) Order Resolution, 2016, is hereby affirmed.
