

THE FOREST ACT

The Forest (Bowden Pen Forest Reserve) Order, 2016

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 5(a) of the Forest Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:-

- Citation. 1. This Order may be cited as the Forest (Bowden Pen Forest Reserve) Order, 2016.
- Schedule. 2. The areas specified in Part I of the Schedule which are delineated on the map set out in Part II thereof, is hereby declared to be a forest reserve and shall be known as Bowden Pen Forest Reserve.

SCHEDULE

(Paragraph 2)

Part I. Description of area declared to be Bowden Pen Forest Reserve

The forest reserve to be known as Bowden Pen Forest Reserve is described as follows-

All that parcel of Crown Land situated in the parish of St. Thomas, and registered in the Registry Book of Titles as part of Bowden Pen (Volume 1162 Folio 54) and part of Edgars Rio Grande (Volume 1004 Folio 160) and containing by surveys 185.80 hectares and butting and bounding as follows –

Northerly

on sections of the Blue Mountain Forest Reserve (Rio Grande Block, District 22) in the possession of the Commissioner of Lands, on sections of Mill Bank registered at Volume 220 Folio 92 and Volume 1175 Folio 815 now in the possession of The Commissioner of lands, and on Fish Brook in possession of the Commissioner of Lands;

Easterly

on the parochial road from Bowden Ben to Four Feet;

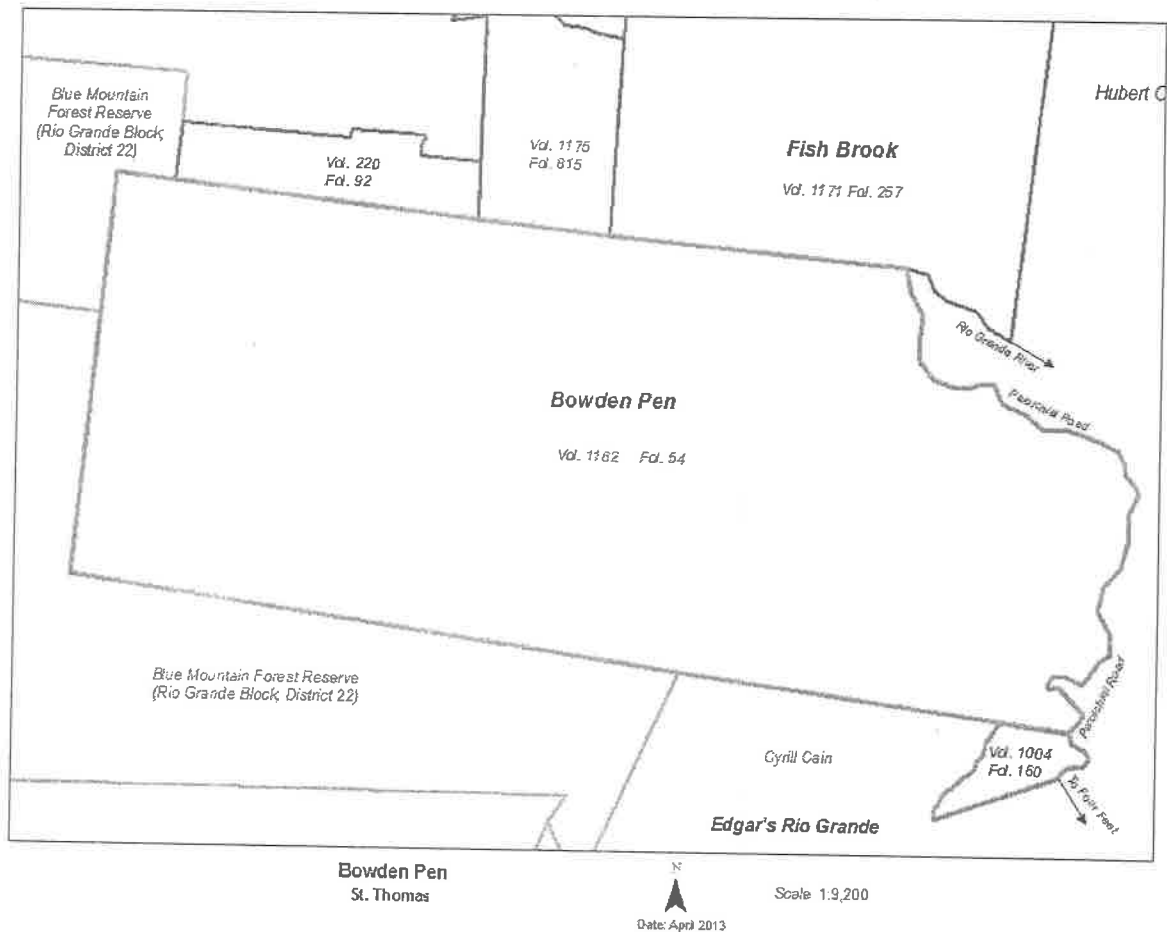
Southerly

on sections of Edgar Rio Grande in possession of Cyril Cain, and on sections of the Blue Mountain Forest Reserve (Rio Grande Block, District 22) in the possession of the Commissioner of Lands;

Westerly

on sections of the Blue Mountain Forest Reserve (Rio Grande Block, District 22) in the possession of the Commissioner of Lands or however otherwise the same land may be butted, bounded, known or otherwise described.
